Without you, O Venkateshwara, I am an orphan. I always keep remembering your name. O Venkatesa, kindly be pleased with me and bestow me with your love and grace.

By the divine grace of Lord Sri Venkateswara, who resides with Sridevi, Bhudevi, and other Parivara Devatas, the Sri Venkateswara Swamy Temple of Colorado, which was inaugurated in the summer of 2013, is now completing its 12-year journey, known as a Pushkara Kaala. Over these years, the temple has fulfilled its purpose both as a place of worship and a cultural center, with Lord Sri Venkateswara watching over the material and spiritual well-being of his devotees. While the divine remains eternal, shining brightly through time, the structures that house this divinity may, over time, require improvements and repairs.

The Agama Shastras prescribe a sacred ritual called **Kumbhabhishekam**, which is performed every 12 years to renew the energy of the Deities and reinvigorate faith among the followers. Kumbhabhishekam derives from the words Kumbha meaning vessel or pot and Abhishekam meaning a ritual bath. Reconsecration of the Deities is also called as Samprokshana. Before the event, and during the ongoing improvements, a Balalayam is set up with the Utsava Murthis. In accordance with Agama procedures, the priests temporarily transfer the Prana Shakti from the Moola Vigrahas into Mantra Jalam placed in Kalashas. These Kalashas are then positioned in the Balalayam for worship and nitya aradhana.

The Kumbhabhishekam is a **five-day event**, during which a team of esteemed priests from temples across the USA will join our temple priests to enhance the ceremony. A temporary Yagashala will be set up with six Homa Kundams (fire altars) to carry out the prescribed fire sacrifices (Sata Sahasra Ashtothara ahutis to be offered to the fire god). The daily religious activities will follow the practices of the Sri Pancharathra Agama Shastra, including Japam, Homam, Kumbha Aradhana, Archana, Nivedana, and Purificatory rites.

On the final day, **Saturday May 10th**, following the Maha Purnahuti, the priests will carry the Kumbhas filled with consecrated water possessing divine energy in a grand procession to the main temple accompanied by the vibrations of Vedic chants and the melodious sounds of Nadaswaram. At the auspicious muhurtham, the Acharyas will perform Samprokshana to the Gopurams and Moola Vigrahas with the sanctified water in the Kumbhas. During this time, amidst the sacred chants, the Divine Energy will be transferred back from the Kumbhas to the existing Deities.

According to the shastras, The Kumbhabhishekam that takes place every twelve years is as significant as the original Prana Pratishtha ceremony. Participation in this auspicious event is believed to bring numerous karmic benefits, offering a wonderful opportunity for devotees to support the temple. We warmly invite you to join us in this sacred ceremony, immerse yourself in the divine experience, and receive abundant blessings from the Lord.


