



Activities & Accomplishments

- With the blessing of Sri Venkateswara Swamy, we are getting very positive feedback from devotees on the services we are providing at the temple.
- Temple is open on time everyday as per schedule and devotee attendance has increased year over year during weekends and events.
- Priests are instructed to treat all devotees equally and make them feel welcome at the temple.
- Priests strictly follow their schedules, take prior permissions for any deviations and performed events on time.
- Priests get live updates on private puja schedules on their smart phones.





- Priests dakshina amounts are entered in the POS every week and the total amount calculated per month will be sent to the treasurer.
- We have performed 396 private pujas between January 1st and December 17th of 2023.
- Garlands preparation at the temple saved more than 80%.
